



Lesson Planning Task for Module Two Applicants

In order to evaluate your suitability for our Delta Module 2 course we need to get a good sense of how effectively you can teach and plan for teaching. Unfortunately, we can't come to observe you teach, so instead we ask you to plan a lesson. Use this as an opportunity to show how well-focussed your teaching can be. Please read the following task carefully. Failure to follow these instructions may result in a delay of the processing of your application.

Task

Write a lesson plan for a lesson (between 40 and 60 minutes) with a class that is familiar to you, You may write the plan in any format, but please include the following:

- a brief profile of the class, explaining who they are, why they are learning English and what sort of problems they have;
- aims / outcomes for the lesson;
- an outline of your intended procedure for the lesson;
- a prose commentary explaining what the lesson is about, why it will be useful, and how the learning will happen;
- **a copy of any material or exercises used** – these can be published materials, adapted from a published source or self-written.

Important

Your lesson should include the following:

- a focus on clarifying the meaning, form and use of either (a) a discrete grammatical item, (b) a number of grammatical items (e.g. in a text) or (c) a set of lexical items together with learner practice where appropriate;
- work on helping learners become more skilful at reading or listening.
