Course summary

This course helps subject teachers improve their English for use inside and outside the classroom. Participants will develop their speaking and listening skills, expand their vocabulary, improve their language accuracy and become more confident users of English. Teachers will also gain useful new ideas for activities and tasks they can use in their own classrooms.



This course is for:

- Teachers of subjects other than English who would like to update and improve their own English.
- Teachers of CLIL or who work in English medium contexts.
- Participants with a **pre-intermediate (A2) – intermediate (B1)** language level.
- Teachers who would like to be more confident using English in the classroom.

What you will gain by attending the course:

- the ability to confidently manage and teach lessons in English
- a greater range of vocabulary
- improvements in your pronunciation
- development of speaking and listening skills
- more awareness of English grammar and ability to use it with greater accuracy and confidence
- greater understanding of a range of techniques and strategies for developing language awareness
- the chance to make professional contacts from other countries and cultures

Course content

This course will cover some or all of the following topics:

- Vocabulary development, e.g. common idioms, phrasal verbs
- Classroom language
- Listening and speaking skills development
- Pronunciation
- Subject specific language (e.g. maths, science, music, geography etc.)
- English grammar (work on specific tenses and other grammatical features to be determined according to participants' needs)
- Learning how to learn English
- Giving a short presentation

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
